1. Number of workers



There are 62,147 people employed in Real Estate & Rental Services, or about 7% of all workers covered by Ringa Hora, or 2% of all NZ workers.


2. Age

Businesses

1. Number of business



There are 123,198 businesses in Real Estate & Rental Services, or about 42% of all businesses covered by Ringa Hora and 21% of all NZ businesses. This is almost three times as many businesses as the sector with the second highest number of businesses within Ringa Hora


50% of people in Real Estate & Rental Services are self-employed, considerably than the 17% in both NZ overall and in all Ringa Hora sectors, and by far the highest of all Ringa Hora sectors.

On average less than 1 person works in each business in Real Estate & Rental Services compared with 4 in the NZ economy as a whole and 3 across all Ringa Hora industries.

Economic contribution



The Real Estate & Rental Services sector contributes \$21.2 Billion to GDP. This is 6.5% of NZ's GDP and 21.2% of Ringa Hora's total contribution to GDP.

The Real Estate & Rental Services sector generates close to \$400.000 per full time equivalent worker. This is almost triple the total across the NZ economy and is the highest of Ringa Hora's sectors.

GDP generated by the Real Estate & Rental Services sector grew by 1.6% per annum from 2016 - 2021, this is lower than both the Ringa Hora total of 2.7% and NZ total of 2.3%.

The average worker in Real Estate & Rental Services earned \$67,100 in 2020. This is marginally higher than the NZ average of \$64,000 and the Ringa Hora average of \$60,000

40% of all workers in Real Estate & Rental Services have no post-school qualification. This is similar to 40% of workers in all Ringa Hora sectors and 38% of workers across the NZ economy.

There are 6 qualifications relating to Real Estate & Rental Services, spread across levels 4-6. These make up 6% of all of Ringa Hora's qualifications.

No. of standards

There are 102 standards relating to the Real Estate & Rental Services sector, mostly at levels 4 and 5 with smaller number at levels 3 and 6.

3. No. of learners in 2021

There were around 7,200 people undertaking qualifications relating to Real Estate & Rental Services in 2021. This is 13% of all learners undertaking qualifications in Ringa Hora's coverage.
