



“I muri nei kia pai ki aku Taonga Māori, Taonga Pākēhā, kia tae ake te haruru o te reo kia hau i te Reinga”

“After I have gone be good to my Māori people and my European people, let the thunder of your voice reach me in the spirit land”

Te Wharepouri 1842.

1866

- Palmerston North Māori Reserve Trust

1987

- Treaty claim lodged

2003 - 16 May

- Waitangi Tribunal Report Submitted


2009

Business Model Set By Tūpuna - 1800's


