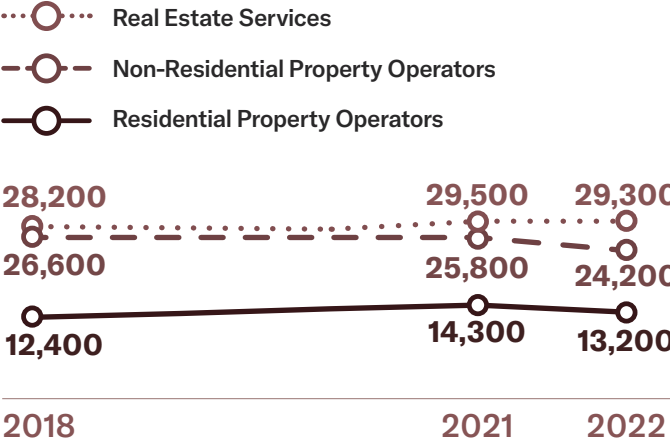

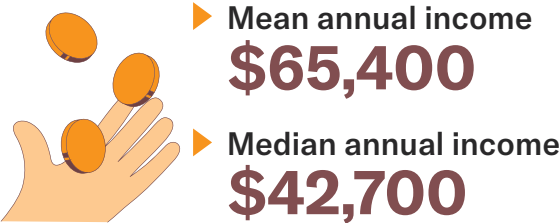

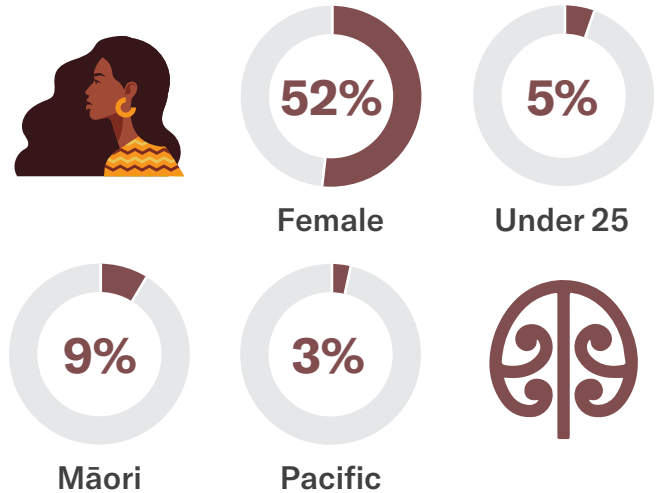
Workforce by selected industries



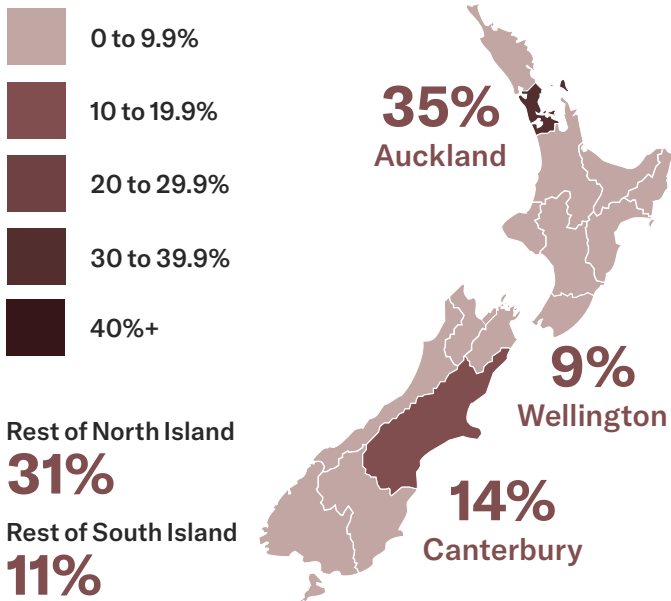
Income (2022)



Workforce demographics (2022)



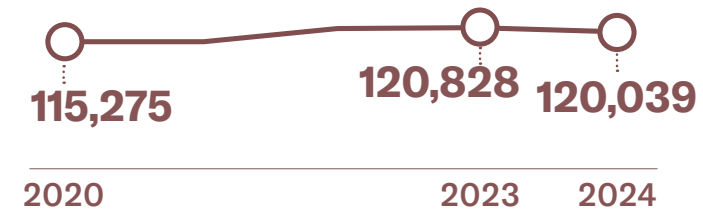
Regional distribution (2022)

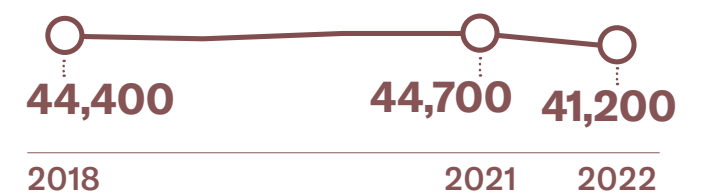
Decrease of total businesses between February 2023 and February 2024



Businesses by selected industries

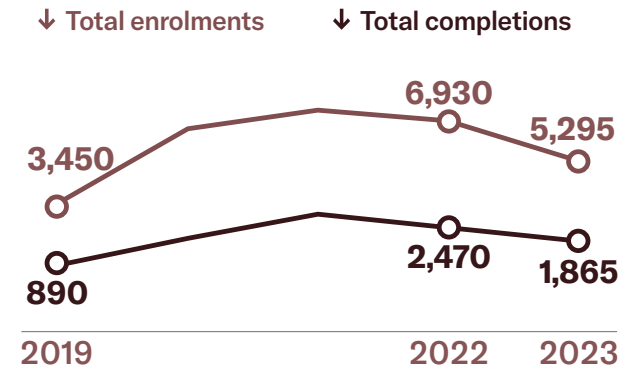


Decrease in total self-employed workers in 2022 compared to 2021

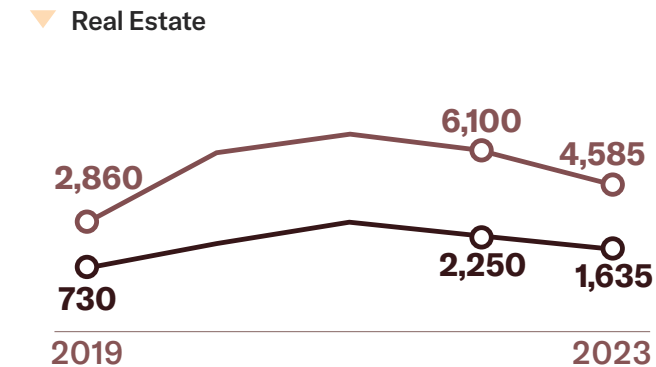
