Kawa | Foundation Principles

We are committed to working collectively to ensure that our workforce functions and duties give effect to Te Tiriti o Waitangi and support Māori Crown relations. We aim to do this by supporting the aspirations of Māori to fulfil present and future workforce development and talent needs. We will implement approaches that are sustainable and relevant to the future of both the Māori and wider Aotearoa economies.

Tikanga | Te Tiriti o Waitangi in Ohu Ahumahi

The Preamble

Preserves the authority of rangatira Māori and promises to maintain and strengthen relationships between Māori and the Crown.

Kāwanatanga | Governance

We establish Ohu Ahumahi functions and duties that honour Te Tiriti o Waitangi and support Māori Crown relations. Our processes, actions, decision-making and delivery are informed and shaped equally by Māori and non-Māori worldviews and perspectives. We work in partnership with tangata whenua.

Tino Rangatiratanga | Sovereignty

We recognise tangata whenua authority and autonomy. We take active steps to support access, resource as non-Māori. We decision-making. We will ensure that the taonga of whānau, hapū, and iwi Māori including te reo, ngā tikanga and mātauranga Māori, are under their control.

Öritetanga | Equitable outcomes for Māori

We work to ensure that Māori have equal rights, access, resources, opportunities, and outcomes as non-Māori. We undertake specific actions to ensure equitable opportunities and outcomes for tangata whenua.

Wairuatanga

We recognise wairuatanga is distinctive to Māori ways of being, doing, and knowing. We will ensure Māori are able to practise their expressions of wairuatanga.
